areas of industrial research shall be taken up besides undertaking a Technology Development and Utilization Programme for Women (TDUPW).

The TDUPW Project entitled "Training of Progressive Technologies and Capacity Building for Himalayan Community" awarded to Himalayan Environmental Studies and Conservation

Organization (HESCO), Dehradun was reviewed on 29.11.2024. Around 1213 women and 10 SHGs have been trained in processing of Dhoopagarbati, herbal gulal and turmeric capsules (in collaboration with CIMAP and NBRI) in Dehradun valley and nearby villages. A total of 31 women have started their own enterprises with an income ranging from Rs. 36,000 to Rs. 1.2 lakh annually. An oil distillation plant is being established in the village of Chibow, Chakrata under the project.
